

Proud Winning Owners

As members of this organisation you would all be seeking to be a proud owner of a winner. Perhaps any winner, or aim higher for a city winner, or higher again for a black-type winner, and yet higher – a Group One winner.

Achieve any of these and you'll most likely obtain a photo of the success or a DVD, USB, or some memento of the feat.

At the ATC Heritage Centre there are hundreds of photos of race finishes and return to scale photos, and many a photo of a proud owner greeting his or her "champion" to its reception in the winners stall.

I've picked three for you.

Mr. Doyle and Show County:

In the late 1980s, early 1990s, one of the best sprinters in Sydney Town was Show County. He won numerous races including 11 black-type races such as the Breeders' Plate, Silver Slipper Stakes, Maribyrnong Plate and Canterbury Stakes, among others. This photo (above) shows him, and rider Brian Wood, being led back to scale by his owner Mr. M. Doyle after winning the San Domenico Stakes at Warwick Farm in August 1989.



Mr. Haley and Tulloch:

An owner who had several good racehorses over a very long period of time, Mr. Evelyn Haley saved the best to last. At a grand old age Haley raced Tulloch – an immortal of the Australian Turf who won 36 of his 53 starts, including three Sires Produce Stakes, three Derbies, two St. Legers, a Rosehill Guineas, Caulfield Guineas, Caulfield Cup, Brisbane Cup, Cox Plate and upwards of 20 weight-for-age races. Haley is seen in this photo (left) greeting his champ and doesn't he look happy and proud.

Miss B. Palmer and Talisman:

Staying races were still the order of the day in the mid 1950's and one of the better handicap stayers was a son of Midstream called Talisman. When he came back to the yard after winning the two mile Sydney Cup of 1955 he was greeted with a pat (and maybe a kiss) by a delighted owner Miss B. Palmer.


