



HISTORICALLY SPEAKING

The Race Photography of Fred George

Among the hundreds of framed paintings and photographs in the ATC Heritage Collection there are many of the works of F W George. Fred George was a photographer who specialised in the 1940/1950s in photographing race finishes to sell to the connections of the winning horses.

He was a pioneer of the hand-touched colourising of the black and white photography of the day. Up until the 1940s almost all race finishes and return to scale photographs were black and white because colour photography of moving subjects was not of a high standard and was very expensive. When Fred George began to hand-touch his black and white photographs into colour it was a revolutionary process. He was brilliant at it and soon others started to copy him and Akers and Tony Simon in Melbourne did the same. Others tried and failed lamentably.

Through the 1940s into the early 1960s most race finishes were hand-coloured in this style. Combined with some wonderful calligraphy captioning the photographs with details of the triumph and recording the names of the connections, many a treasured memory was created to adorn the homes of racing folk of the time.

Colour photography took over in the 1960s but the tradition of producing race finish photos with details of the race on the surrounding mount remains to this day.

Fred George was a prolific worker and if you haunt second-hand shops, garage sales, car boot sales and the like you will come across his work. The man himself remains little-known. Perhaps he liked it that way, but this writer has tried hard to find out more about him and found precious little. If any of you know more, I would love to learn of it.
