
Variety in the ATC Heritage Centre Exhibitions

As I have said before, the ATC Heritage Collection housed at the ATC Heritage Centre on Randwick Racecourse, with displayed items located at all the Sydney racecourses and in the ATC Administration Building at Randwick, has a very varied range of items.

I've chosen two here and they could hardly be more different.

Celebrities of the Turf



This extraordinary pictorial chart which is framed and looks spectacular on the wall where it is currently displayed is huge, it measures about 130 x 85 cms. It has been very hard to find information about why and who did what to produce it.

It has the name W J Dowman on the bottom and he was an artist of the time, so it seems he was the "graphic artist" who designed and drew the layout. Recent searching found that it was published in early 1920 by a firm named Paver and Whittington and was commercially available to the public. Since there is a preponderance of images of the leading bookmakers of the day down the sides it's possible there was some subsidy from them involved, but there are also images of other well known racing people and some very good photographs of the equine stars as well.

The famous finish of the Craven Plate of 1918, billed as the "Greatest finish ever seen on Randwick racecourse" features above images of Poitrel and Gloaming. Beneath

them, another famous image, of the AJC Derby dead-heaters of 1919 Artilleryman and Richmond Main nosing each other in the mounting yard after the race. Below that a row of the leading riders of the time such as "Midget" McLachlan, Jim Pike, Albert Wood, Myles Connell and Ken Bracken.

Around the perimeter, apart from the bookmakers, are photographs of such racing renowned figures as Harry Rayner, Frank McGrath, John Mayo and others.

A remarkable piece of work and never have I seen one except in the ATC Heritage Collection.

Bill Burnett's Riding Boots

Beautifully polished and gleaming are W. Burnett's riding boots. Most jockeys treat their riding gear with great affection. It helps also to impress owners and trainers of their dedication to their craft. Bill or Billy Burnett was of that ilk it seems.



Born in Scotland in 1944 and coming to Australia as a boy in 1956, W. Burnett rode from 1960 to the late 1970s. He did moderately well as an apprentice to George McCahon at Rosehill, riding his first winner Martian King in 1961. He moved from McCahon to Warwick Farm trainer Bill Stripe and then to Rosehill trainer Bert Lyell to complete his apprenticeship.

Highlights of his career in Australia were wins on Shakedown, Somebody, Dentur Queen, Raad, Lease King, Itchy Feet and Regal Gauntlet. His later riding years were in Hong Kong and he featured prominently in the premiership for several years.

BOBS SCHEME UPDATE

Segenhoe Stud-owned gelding **Park Avenue** kept his unbeaten record intact with a last stride win at Royal Randwick on May 29.

The youngster came from last with a barnstorming finish to grab runner-up Winning Verse right on the line.

A son of Fastnet Rock, the two-year-old had previously won on debut at Wyong on May 13.

Jean Van Overmeire was aboard Park Avenue and said the gelding is on an upward spiral.

"I think he has a bright future. Michael [Freedman; co-trainer] has always had a big opinion of him.

"He has not yet matured and has a lot of upside; he will get more distance.

"Once the penny drops, he will develop into a very smart horse."

A \$200K purchase at the Magic Millions, Park Avenue has now won more than \$28,000 in BOBS bonuses with plenty more to come.

Nicci's Fling [by Nicconi] was another to snare a BOBS bonus at the same meeting.

The filly flashed home late under Rachel King to narrowly defeat Bright Rubick.

Her BOBS tally has now topped \$33K with three wins including two previous victories at Bathurst and Nowra.

Sebring colt **Gravina** was a third galloper to earn a BOBS bonus on the day after bolting in with Race 5 with apprentice Reece Jones aboard.

The Joe Pride-trained Private Eye currently leads the BOBS bonus tally with five bonuses for nearly \$70,000 in additional prizemoney.


